**Hypericum\* (St. John's Wort):** a semi-deciduous, native shrub with clusters of yellow flowers and spectacular fall foliage

Need 84 of these.



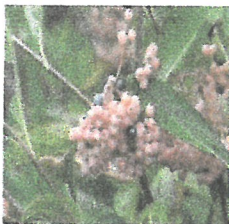
**Fothergilla:** an ornamental shrub with white, honey-scented flowers and deep green leaves; has neon- bright fall foliage

Need 11 of these.



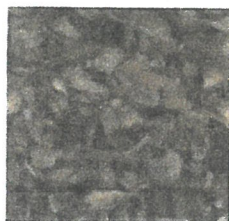
**Ninebark\*:** has green foliage with white to pink flowers; in the winter the bark peels back in layers

Need 3 of these.



**Viburnum nudum\*:** a white flowering, native shrub with berries that transform from green to vivid shades of pink or blue; Rich, deep red foliage in the fall; birds love these!

Need 11 of these.



**Pine Bark Mulch:** a large amount of dark brown mulch is needed to present a cohesive look to the landscape and serves to control weeds and water
